

Little Sutton Primary Assessment Results 2015

During the Reception year the children work towards achieving Early Learning Goals. Throughout the year the children's progress is assessed and there is a final assessment of whether the children are still working towards the Early Learning Goals (emerging), have achieved (expected) or have gone beyond them (exceeded). The national expectation is that the children will have met them (expected).

At the end of Year 1 all children nationally are required to undertake a phonic assessment. The children have to achieve the pass rate. If they not achieve it, the test is taken again at the end of Year 2.

At the end of Key Stage 1 children undertake a range of assessments and tests in order for the teacher to accurately provide a teacher assessment level. The national expected level for Year 2 is 2b. Level 3 is above the expected level.

At the end of Key Stage 2, children undertake tests in Maths, Reading and a Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar test. These are externally marked. In addition the children undertake a writing assessment, which is marked internally and moderated with the schools in the Learning Trust for Excellence (LTE) to provide a levelled assessment for the children. The national expected level is L4b. For writing the level is L4. Level 5 is above expected attainment and Level 6 is well above.
