Key Stage 1 SATs - Teacher Assessment Results

In Key Stage 1 children undertook a reading test, English, grammar, punctuation and spelling test (optional) and a maths test. Teachers then use these test results to inform their teacher assessments which have to be submitted to the DfE. This year children were assessed at pre-key stage, working towards the standard, at the expected standard or at greater depth.

Key Stage 2 SATs - Teacher Assessment and Test Results

At Key Stage 2 the children undertook 1 reading paper, an English, punctuation, grammar and spelling test and 3 maths papers. The children's marks were converted to a scaled score from 80 to 120. The expected standard was a scaled score of 100.
