Each week you will study an aspect of geography in class. You will then be required to complete homework for your independent project based on this task.

WEEK 1 (10/10/18)

1. Pick a country of interest from the following list:

EUROPE: Albania, Andorra, Armenia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Kosovo, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Malta, Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, The Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, San Marino, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, Vatican City.

NORTH AMERICA: Antigua and Barbuda, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Canada, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Grenada, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, St Kitts and Nevis, St Lucia, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad & Tobago, USA.

SOUTH AMERICA: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Columbia, Ecuador, Guyana, Paraguay, Peru, Suriname, Uruguay, Venezuela.

2. Leave a few pages blank (for your contents and introduction later).

4. Include a map which shows where the country is in the world, the name of the continent, the location of towns/ cities, physical features such as rivers and mountains, nearest/surrounding countries/ seas/ ocean and any major tourist attractions.

5. Describe in full sentences the location of the country and its main physical features (refer to your map for help). Describe the country's natural beauty - e.g. lakes, beaches, forests, waterfalls, mountains or wildlife. How does it compare with the UK?

6. Include some pictures or photographs of the country and its physical features with a description- where are they? How big/small? What makes them special?
